The English as a Second Language (ESL) Program at California Graduate School of Theology (Cal Grad) is available to all nonnative English speakers who wish to improve and enhance their English skills in the areas of receptive language, expressive language, articulation, oral-motor, fluency, and listening. For students who complete our non-degree ESL Program, a certificate of completion will be awarded. However, classes do not earn academic credit at Cal Grad.

Prospective students applying for admission to the ESL Program at Cal Grad must be 18 years old or older and hold a high school diploma or its equivalent. Admission into the ESL Program does not constitute admission to any other academic program at Cal Grad. Students will not receive academic credit for courses in the ESL Program.

Required Documents for Admissions

All prospective students must complete the following:

- 1. Submit a completed admission application form with a \$100 non-refundable application fee
- 2. Provide official transcript from high school and a copy of your high school diploma
- 3. Provide a copy of government issued photo ID
- 4. Take the ESL Program Placement Test

International Students Only:

- 1. Photocopies of U.S. Visa and I-94
- 2. Bank statements: \$24,000 or above (need to have at least \$3,000 for each dependent)
- 3. Transfer Eligibility Form (if transfer student)
- 4. I-20 from previous school (if transfer student)
